In an effort to build the Endowment for the President Benjamin Harrison Home, the Board of Directors and Staff are pleased to offer Planned Giving as a means for friends of the museum to support the only preserved memorial to the 23rd President of the United States, President Benjamin Harrison.

PLANNED GIVING OPTIONS

We invite members and loyal friends to preserve the legacy of the educational, social and historical value the museum provides to nearly 28,000 people annually, including 17,000 elementary students for education programs. The Harrison Home suggests three highlighted planned giving options that may be adapted to gifts of varying size.

GIFT BY BEQUEST

A gift by bequest can be made to the Harrison Home in the form of an Estate Gift or Gift of Stock. Estate bequests may include a set dollar amount

from an Estate or a percentage of the total Estate as designated by the Donor. Gifts of Stock would be transferred to the Home by a Donor's Estate Plan. All gifts are recognized at the time they are committed, and the Harrison Home would be able to provide legal assistance to coordinate the completion of a bequest on the part of a donor.

GIFT OF LIFE INSURANCE

Either through the transfer of an existing life policy or a contribution of the funds necessary to purchase a new policy, a donor is able to make a substantial bequest to the Home, without relinquishing control of funds needed for family support or estate needs.

Other benefits to a gift of life insurance include: current income tax deduction and estate tax savings; less cost to the estate and heirs' and donor rewards experienced during their lifetime.

The Home is prepared to assist in reviewing a gift of Life Insurance, as well as providing administrative and technical policy assistance. Naming the Harrison Home as the beneficiary is also an alternative.

CHARITABLE GIFT ANNUITY

Through the use of Charitable Gift Annuities, a donor can transfer an asset to the Harrison Home yet have the Donor receive a fixed dollar amount for a specified time period. The Donor receives a current income tax deduction, due to making a gift to the Harrison Home while also providing for his or her own income or financial support for family members.
